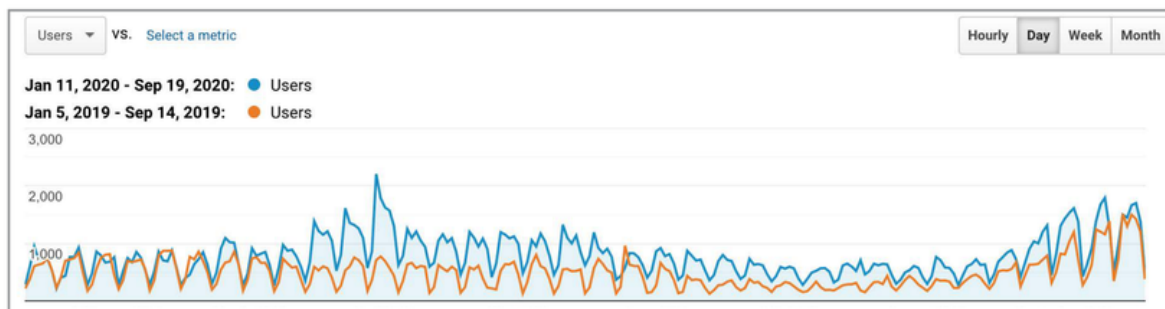
A TRIP TO THE NEW MILESTONES

This year we have all the more reason to be proud of what we have accomplished: We published 141 adapted papers – 59 more than in 2019, despite all the current difficulties. Thirteen of these papers were about COVID. Providing high-quality scientific information in a timely manner has never been as important.

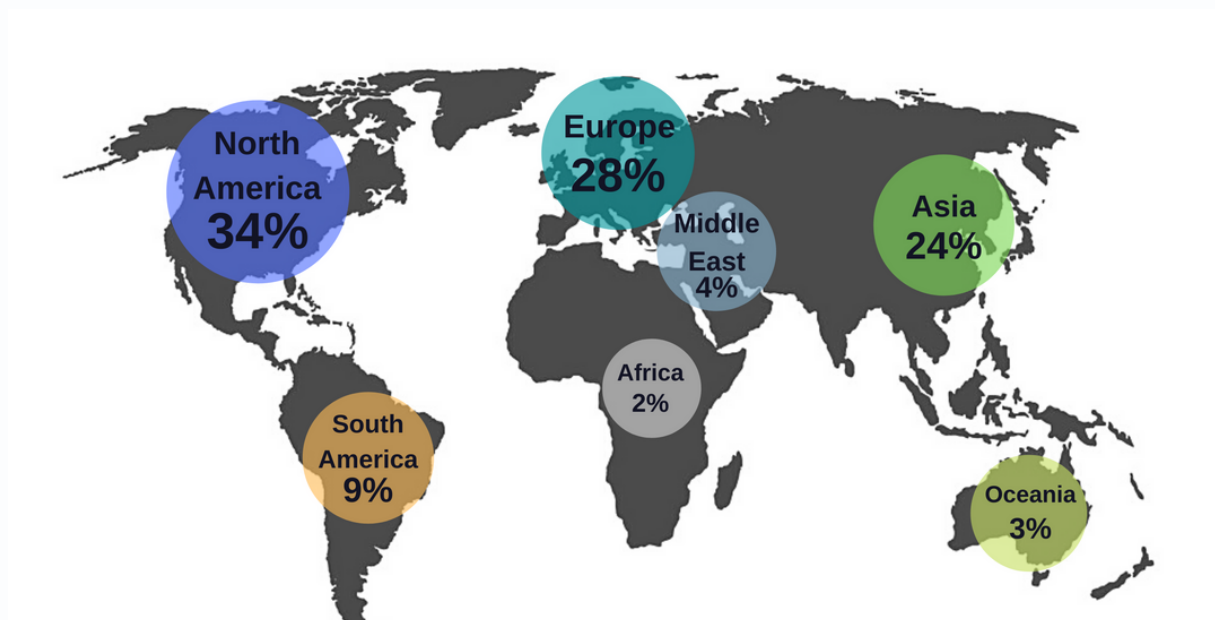


This year, each of our articles was downloaded on average 1000 times.

Just this year, our authors from world doubled compared to last year. Among those regions, North America saw 3% increase, up to 34%.

FUNDRAISING

This year was a milestone for us as a 501(c)3 non-profit organization. We received our first grant from the Al-Futtaim Education Foundation in the amount of \$19,500. We are grateful and humbled by the trust they placed in us. Heading into 2021, we have applied for 6 grants in various other foundations and we are anxiously awaiting the results. For #GeniusAwe2020, we organized our first fundraising campaign for our authors. We raised \$10600 from 12 individual donors whose discretionary generosity means the world to us.



We were invited to take part in a Future Global Young Scientists Summit for non-profits, which helped us identify a year's worth of improvements that we will be implementing next year.
